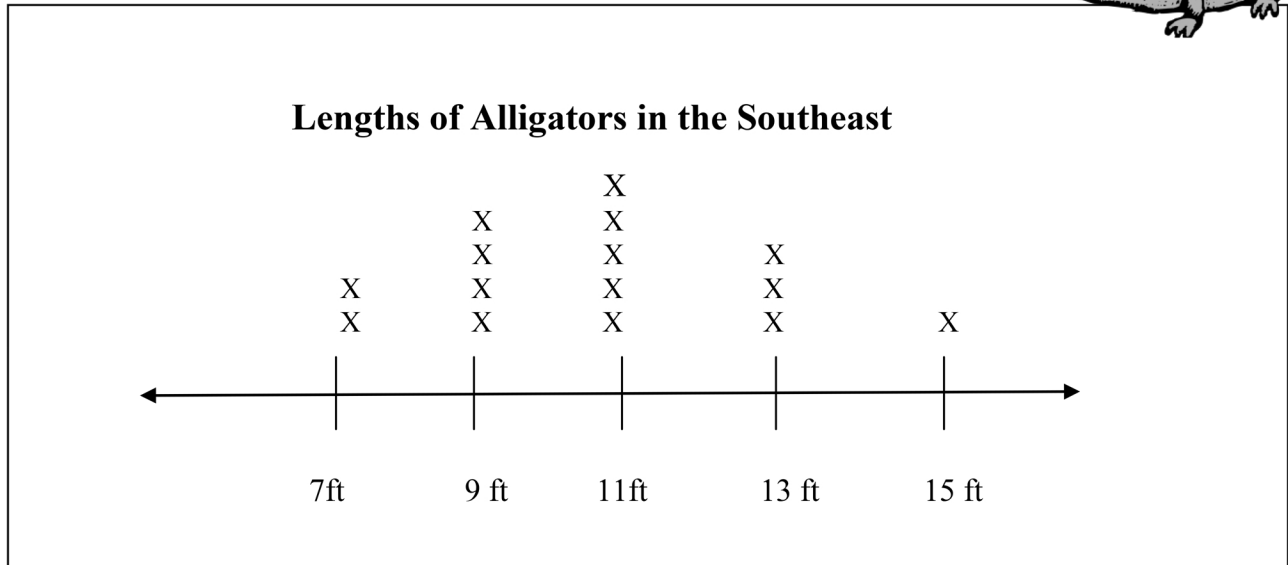

Working with Line Plots



The Good Earth Conservation Corps tracks lengths of alligators captured and relocated in the Southeast. The line plot above shows the length of each captured alligator for the month of April. Use the line plot to answer the questions.

1. How many alligators were captured and relocated during April?
2. How many alligators were at least 11 feet long?
3. How many alligators were less than 11 feet long?
4. Adult, female alligators are usually between 7 and 11 feet long. If two of the alligators less than 11 feet were male, how many were female?
5. If 3 of the alligators that had a length of 11 feet or greater were female, how many were male?
6. If all of the alligators were placed tail to snout in a straight row, what would be the length of the row?
